$1 / 3$ yard Bandana Allover - Green (C) 557-66
$1 / 2$ yard Gingham Check - Gray (D) 552-90
2/3 yard Farm Scenic - Green (E) 553-66
$11 / 4$ yards Tossed Farm Animals - Blue (F) 550-11
$31 / 2$ yards Bandana Allover - Blue (Backing)
557-11
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:
-(1) $18^{1 / 2 "} \times 19$ " rectangle, centered on a large block.

- (4) $81 / 4$ " squares, each centered on a small block.

From the Folio Basics - Butter (B), cut:

- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 " x 19 " strips.
- (2) 2 " $\times 21 \frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $81 / 4 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $111 / 4 "$ strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Bandana Allover - Green (C), cut:
-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $201 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Gingham Check - Gray (D), cut:
-(2) $13 / 4$ " $\times 401 / 2$ " WOF strips.
- (3) $13 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $13 / 4 " x 43 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) $11 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Farm Scenic - Green (E), cut:

- (1) $201 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $201 / 2 " \times 51 / 2 "$ strips and (2) $5^{1 / 2 "} \times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ strips.

From the Tossed Farm Animals - Blue (F), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 43$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 53 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Bandana Allover - Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) $61 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61 " x 61 " back.

Block Assembly
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " x 19 "

Fabric B strip to each side of the $18 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 19$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 " x $21^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure $201 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$.

2. Sew (1) $2 " \times 81 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $81 / 4 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x $11^{1 / 4 "}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Trim the block to measure
$101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

3. Sew together (1) 2 " $\times 201 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) $201 / 2 \times 1 \times 1 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 201 / 2$ " Fabric D strip and (1) 2" x $201 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) $101 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ Block Five strip (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.

4. Sew together (1) 2 " $\times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric C strip, (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 20^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric D strip, (1) $51 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 201 / 2$ "

Fabric D strip and (1) 2 " $\times 201 / 2$ " Fabric C strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) $101 / 2 \times 201 / 2 "$ Block Three strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Three strip.

5. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of (1) Block Three strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 5). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 6. Sew (1) Block Two strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
7. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $13 / 4 " \times 43$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
8. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times 43 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 53 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
9. Layer and quilt as desired.
10. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
11. Bind as desired.
